## THE MISSISSIPPI STATE FAIR REMEMBERS GEORGE RAWORTH

George Raworth loved antique cars, and he loved the Mississippi State Fair. The first two car shows at the Fair were outside. A walk down the Midway included seeing all the cars lined up in pristine rows with hoods up, chrome polished, and paint gleaming. By 1987, the show had moved into the Trade Mart building, and the Fair

Car Show was a family tradition. By 2019, the grandchildren of the first spectators were bringing their children to the show. Fond memories were shared between club members and show attendees.

When Dr. Lester Spell, Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce, and members of the Antique Vehicle Club of Mississippi (AVCM) met in the late 90's, a partnership was born. The AVCM and the Mississippi Department of Agriculture and Commerce (MDAC) continue that relationship today. Behind the scenes George and the AVCM members consistently tweaked the exhibit to enhance the experience and provide value to the Fair. Unique to the Fair Show, the club members elect to have their cars judged on a point system known as Concourse. MDAC provides the trophies to the winners. Raworth became the spokesperson to ensure that the Fairgrounds Director and the Commissioner of Agriculture understood the show's foundation and the significance of a judged show. Also, Raworth spearheaded the fun part of the judging where the Governor, the Agriculture Commissioner, the Fairgrounds Director, and other elected officials pick their favorite car and present a plaque to the owner of the vehicle. Those are coveted awards.

Over the years, George met with agriculture commissioners Dr. Lester Spell, Cindy Hyde-Smith, and Andy Gipson. Their support of the show remains steadfast. He also scheduled early meetings for the logistics. The show part of the Fair began each July with a meeting between the Fairgrounds Director and George. These meetings have enhanced the relationship and the car show became as much a part of the Fair as the Midway and other exhibits. In addition, George worked with Jamie Laird, Trade Mart Manager, and the Trade Mart staff who are instrumental in a successful show.

One of George's great passions was antique cars. He was a preservationist in his chosen hobby. The Fair Car Show was a way to enjoy his vehicles, educate the public on automobile history, and encourage others to preserve that history. He was an advocate of the partnership between MDAC and the AVCM until his death January 18, 2020.
